### Rationale

Rosehill College is committed to providing the opportunity for its students to participate in high quality learning experiences outside the classroom, in order to enhance their intellectual, social and emotional development.

The learning experiences outside the classroom will enrich the curriculum by enabling students to succeed in a variety of achievement objectives.

The learning experiences outside the classroom will promote students' appreciation of our heritages and differing perspectives about the environment.

The learning experiences outside the classroom will provide students with opportunities for adventure and challenge, as well as developing their skills by participating in a variety of cultural, recreational and sporting activities in a safe and confident manner.

### Guidelines

1. All EOTC activities must be fully justified in terms of the New Zealand curriculum
2. All procedures relating to the planning and conducting of EOTC activities must be fully carried out by the Teacher in Charge. This includes the implementation of all health and safety procedures; including a detailed Safety Action Plan.
3. The Rosehill College School-Wide Rules apply to all EOTC activities.
4. The Board of Trustees will be informed of, and approve, high risk and overnight EOTC activities.
5. The Board of Trustees will annually review evidence of compliance with EOTC procedures.
